Please be careful when calculating entry fees!

There are 4 separate events on the weekend – Saturday I & II Obedience Trials and Sunday Rally I & II Trials. If you are entering a dog in more than one event, the "First Entry" fee must be paid for each event.

Jump Height is required for all obedience and rally classes with jumps.

Entries in these classes will be arranged in ascending jump height order. Handlers with multiple dogs of the same height in the same class will have those dogs separated in the running order.

Transfers will be allowed.

Transfer form must be submitted to the onsite trial secretary at least 30 minutes before the start of each trial. Transfer forms will also be accepted prior to the day of the trial. (Chapter 1, Section 16 of the Obedience Regulations and Chapter 1, Section 15 of the Rally Regulations.)

Entries without full fees will not be accepted. Confirmation will be sent via US mail ONLY if an exhibitor does not have an active e-mail address or upon specific request. A Preliminary Confirmation will be sent to the email address on the AKC entry form after your entry has been processed. Please review the information in the confirmation for input errors and notify the Trial Secretary of any corrections. **Final confirmation of entry and judging schedule will be sent to the email address on the AKC form after the closing date.** NOTE: If you have not received the Final Confirmation within five days of the trial, please contact the Trial Secretary.

Closing date for entries is 8:00 PM, Wednesday, April 24, 2024. Telephone and fax entries cannot be accepted. Entries may be made online by sending scanned, signed entry form to debstraw@aol.com. Upon receipt of completed form you will be sent a Square Invoice. Click on the link to go to Square and pay the invoice. You will receive confirmation that your payment has been received. You do not need a Square account to use Square for this service. There will be a \$3.00 administration fee for each class using this method. All invoices must be paid by the closing date.

Entries not on official AKC entry forms and photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are not acceptable. Unsigned and illegible entries will not be accepted. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a collection fee of \$35 to the amount of each returned check. An AKC Recording Fee of \$.50 first entry only and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 for first entry and \$3.50 for each additional entry are required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Obedience Trial. (Chapter 11, Section 2 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows effective 1/1/2024). An AKC Recording Fee of \$3.50 is required for each entry in any Licensed or Member Club Rally Trial. (AKC Rally Regulations - Fee Schedule effective January 1, 2024.) These fees are included in the entry fees. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors. No entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors after the published closing date. No refund for over payment of fees if the error is less than \$10.

Refund for bitches in season less \$5 per entry with veterinarian's note submitted to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes before the start of judging.

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. If because of riots, wars, strikes, civil disturbances, national emergencies, health emergencies, and the dictates of law enforcement or of the owners(s) of the grounds and/or facilities or other acts beyond the control of management, it is impossible to open or complete the trials, no refund of entry fee will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, heavy rains, or other circumstances including, but not limited to, the condition of the facilities or grounds and/or the ingress and egress from the

grounds, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance, and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the trials before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. It is the responsibility of the owner or handler to have the dog at ringside when its class is called. Dogs may arrive at any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused. All dogs present must be on leash or confined to a crate except when being judged in the ring.

DIRECTIONS TO THE SHOW SITE

<u>US 460 - From the West of Lynchburg:</u> From 460, take the right-hand exit to 460 E Business (Timberlake Rd.). Proceed for about 3 miles to Route 501. Exit onto 501 North and go about 2 miles to a traffic light at 221.

Continue straight on Rt. 501 N through the light at Rt. 221. At the next light, turn left to stay on Rt. 501 North. At the next light at Boonsboro Rd., turn left (still Rt. 501) and go about 2 miles. Turn left onto Coffee Road (Rt. 644) and go about 2 miles. The Boonsboro Ruritan Club Building is on your right.

<u>US 460 – From the East of Lynchburg:</u> Exit Rt. 460 at Candler's Mountain Rd. (a right turn exit). Follow signs to Rt. 501 North (River Ridge Mall will be on your left, and Days Inn will be on your right.) Take the exit ramp to the right to Rt. 501 North. Follow 501 N for about 3 miles to Lakeside Dr/ Rt. 221. *See italics above.*

<u>US 29 – From the North of Lynchburg:</u> After passing the town of Amherst, stay on Route 29 South. (Do not take Business Rt. 29.) This is the limited-access Madison Heights Bypass. After crossing James River, Rt. 29 will join US 460. Do Not take Rt 501 North Business at Campbell Ave. Continue to Candler's Mountain Rd and follow signs for Rt. 501 North. (River Ridge Mall is on the left, and Days Inn on the right.) Take the exit ramp to the right to Rt. 501 N for about 3 miles to Lakeside Dr./ Rt. 221. *See italics above.*

<u>US 29 – From the South of Lynchburg:</u> Follow Business Rt. 29 North into the city limits (pass River Ridge Mall entrance on your right.) Take the exit ramp to the right to Rt. 501 North and proceed for about 3 miles to Rt. 221. *See italics above.*

- 1. (Variety) If you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in..), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- 2. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., A or B division.
- 3. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
